A lot of things have been said about the frustration and arrogance of the male. Now, courtesy of the Fisher Gallery, you can look at a piece of art dedicated to it.

Local artist Judy Wilson, a weaver by trade, used parts of her husband's and two sons' pasts to make a quilt about the darker side of males.

It was inspired by New Zealand's top quilter Malcolm Harrison who uses old clothes as quilt designs. Ties, shirts, shorts and knickers all feature.

Judy's work is part of the Pakuranga Arts Society Fibre Group Members July Exhibition at the gallery. It closes on July 22.
