

New exhibit at gallery

Maori and Pakeha artists are contributing works which reflect personal responses to the Treaty of Waitangi, to the "Mana Tiriti" exhibition, at the Fisher Gallery in Pakuranga.

Initiated in Wellington earlier this year by Haeata Maori Women's Art Collective, Project Waitangi and the Wellington City Art Gallery, "Mana Tiriti" focuses on the Treaty of Waitangi, issues surrounding it and their effect on New Zealand since 1840.

Artists from all round New Zealand have produced works which reflect their personal responses to current and historical events relating from the signing of the Treaty.

The exhibition now travelling to Auckland from Wellington will include some new responses by Auckland-based artists as some of the original works were unable to tour.

The Fisher Gallery exhibition runs from September 22 — October 21.
